
Goal: Promote broad aspects of the SFS-Q experience to external audiences, while highlighting more detailed content for current students and staff. Since many staff members will be charged with maintaining their sections of the site, the design needs to provide easy ways for them to organize content. Grayboxes allow us to lay out a site without worrying about details or color – they help designers and clients focus on the structure of content.

We started with an office page in the "Services & Administration" section. Users spend the most time on any site on interior pages like this, so the content structure is important to define.



Content Area

- · Left nav gives current section and subpages prominence
- · Right-col allows for related content, office contact details
- Highlighted stories are moved to the bottom of the page, as an afterthought (rather than a distraction)



Header


- · Shortens logo for increased text size, readability
- Promotes audience pages in a prominent place
- · Divides find- and audience-related tasks
- Brings "Apply online" into the context of admissions
- Proposed Search uses Apple-like "suggested links" to increase chance that user finds relevant content.

Development note about "Search" – This search would be Javascript-based and implemented by Viget. It would draw from either an on-page hidden list of links or an external HTML file of suggested links.


- · 'Qatar Campus' bar ties all three site sections
- Main footer area explains GU's presence in the area and the QF's relationship to the school
- Rotating footer/blurbs highlight real degree, main campus links, Georgetown's reputation
- Social media bar displays otherwise unexpected options on-page, rather than hiding them

Feature Area

- Javascript rotating feature with simple treatment for easy updating. Allows GUQ to show off site content, big stories, or evergreen brand features.
- Audience links, prompting users to travel to more specific subpages for relevant content. The larger, expanded Quicklinks area and the links inside Campus Overview are intended to re place the original sub-links in this section.
- Arabic option translates the right column into Arabic and adds specific links




Georgetown University Qatar/CIRS Redesign Homepage Graybox

Content Area

- Left col is the content "fast lane" for current news and stories
- Right col highlights key areas of general interest
- 'Quicklinks' show for audiences viewing on-campus, or audiences that click that tab once. They show a much larger list of scannable links, including customizable "My Links"

Development note about "My Links" - Links should appear here when users click "Add to Quicklinks" on interior pages. This functionality will be implemented by Viget using Javascript and cookies, if time and technology allow. Keybridge, however, would need to set up any IP-detection that shows Quicklinks to campus users by default.


